






Total IT spend by wider public sector buyers, by year and catogery, Q1 2016- Q3 2021





7 out of 10 of the largest IT spenders increased their budgets in the two years to Q3 2021


Year prior to Q3 2021 IT spend of 10 largest wider public sector buyers vs Q3 2018 - Q3 2021 IT spending growth






Top IT suppliers have held their market share at about 33% since 2016, while SME share has grown

In the year to Q3 2021, top IT suppliers had a majority market share in the 4 largest IT buyers




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Overall market growth is driven by contract volume, not higher pricing


Average value of IT contracts awarded by wider public sector bodies, and the volume of contracts awarded, Q1 2016 - Q4 2021 £1.5m







Infrastructure, Support & Maintenance contracts were nearly half the value of IT procurement in 2020 and 2021








